
Dear Megan:

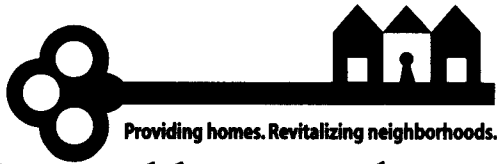


Dear Andrew,
